Hello, everyone! I hope you all are doing well and enjoying some great Oklahoma weather. Hopefully those of you who had damage from the tornado are on the road to getting your property back in order.

The first order of business: Our pool is now open! Enjoy the water or just take some time to relax on the pool deck.

Some of you may not know that over the off-season we remodeled the clubhouse. We had the inside repainted, new countertops installed in both restrooms and in the kitchen, and we also had the floor in the party room completely redone. So if you are needing a place to have a little party or celebration, please check it out.

We have added new mulch to both playgrounds and repaired the border around the 119th E Ave playground (which had been repeatedly vandalized). If you see anyone vandalizing this playground—or any other property in our neighborhood—please immediately call the office or message me at **hoapresident2021@yahoo.com** and I will investigate.

We also will be repairing the fence at the end of 100th Street around the first of July. We have been able to do all of these repairs and remodel the clubhouse through a grant program that the city offers every year. This year I was able to get our neighborhood a grant in the amount of \$7500.00.

Friendly reminders:

1) When you mow your yard, please remember that trimming and edging are also a part of lawn maintenance. Grass clippings are not to be blown into or left in the street.

2) Our covenants state that if you live in the Sawgrass Park or Bailey Ranch neighborhoods, you must park your vehicle in your driveway. Citations concerning this matter have already been issued to several residents.

Finally, our next homeowners meeting will be on Tuesday, November 11. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend.

If you are planning to rent the clubhouse, please call early to make your reservation. The clubhouse has a refrigerator, microwave, and stove for your use along with 8 tables and 48 chairs. The rental fee is \$10 per hour with a minimum of three hours (\$30). The

- **We will be closing the pool at 9 pm on Sundays after school re-opens beginning Sunday, August 17**
- **Pool and clubhouse are under 24 hour surveillance**
- **Pool Closes September 2nd**
Closed on Monday for cleaning and maintenance

• No one is allowed in pool area after 10 PM. If you get locked in, please use your cell phone OR the emergency phone to call an HOA Board Member to let you out. Please do not jump the fence — this can damage the fence and may cause injury.

• Above all, please follow the posted pool rules. They are there for everyone's safety. Failure to comply with these rules will result in the deactivation of your keycard. If your card is deactivated, you must attend the next BREHOA meeting to present your case before the Board for consideration of reactivating your card.

Things to remember...

- **Your keycard will not be activated if dues are not paid.**
- No one under the age of 14 is allowed in the pool or pool area without being accompanied by a responsible adult who is 18 years of age or older.
- There is NO consumption of alcohol or food in the pool area.

Parents of children: Please make sure your babies and toddlers wear proper swimming attire at the pools (i.e. children who are not potty trained need to use diapers made for swimming). If a child has an accident (**feces specifically**) in the pool, by law, we must shut down the pool until maintenance can shock and treat the water. Please be considerate of others. Thank you.

Reminder to Our Neighborhood Residents

- All dogs must be on a leash if out of a fenced yard. Owasso has a leash ordinance and there is a fine for not following this ordinance. Owners must pick up after their dogs and dispose of its waste properly. Please do not leave it in neighbors' yards or in the common areas. **Also, please be considerate of your neighbors if your dog is outside and barking after 10 PM.**
- The playgrounds in Sawgrass have curfews from **dusk until 9**

AM. Please remind your children and teenagers of this curfew.

- Trash carts should be left at the curb for no more than 24 hours. Also, trash carts are not allowed to be stored on porches or driveways, and all refuse needs to be in bags inside the trash cart per City of Owasso.
- Parking at the clubhouse is only for those using the clubhouse, the pool, fishing the ponds, or doing maintenance at the clubhouse or pool. Do not double park or block driveways or mailboxes. There is very limited parking, so we ask you to walk, bicycle, or carpool when possible.
- All residents are to park their vehicle or vehicles in the garage or on the

driveway and avoid parking in the street. Parking in the street produces unsafe conditions and inhibits ease of travel through the neighborhood. It is a violation of our covenants and legal action may be taken if necessary.
